The Child Life team also hosts specialized summer camps for children who face many healthcare challenges.

Through your generosity, all Child Life services are offered free-of-charge to help families focus on healing.

Funded entirely by gifts from our supporters and employees, our accessible **musical playground** brings another element of fun to the healing process.

Physical therapists often use the playground during therapy sessions, and hospital inpatients can enjoy the benefits of play while receiving treatment.



Your gifts funded two custom-made transport ambulances,

designed specifically to transfer critically ill or injured children from other area hospitals to McLane Children's for a higher level of care.

Affectionately known as "Big Brother" and "Little Brother," these mobile intensive care units are equipped with child-friendly amenities, like DVDs, to distract young patients. The ambulances are staffed by a team of registered nurses, respiratory therapists, and emergency medical technicians with advanced training in the stabilization, treatment, and transport of pediatric and neonatal patients.





Funded entirely by your generosity, our 18,000 square-foot **growth spurt** focused on four key areas:

Physical & Occupational Therapy Suite

More than doubled the space for therapy and added a sensory therapy room for children with limited communication skills.

Imaging Department

Added a new 3T MRI machine with increased resolution, reduced scan time, and a fun treehouse design to help ease patients' stress.

Carolyn & Wendell Williams Special Procedures Unit

Four private rooms and new ultrasound equipment to help nurses place PICC lines more quickly and with less pain.

Fikes/CEFCO Emergency Department

Enabled us to treat an additional 10,000 patients annually with six new private rooms, including two convertible "safe rooms" for mental health patients.
